Dear Parents of Grade 11 IB Vietnamese students,

In order to meet the Vietnamese Ministry and Department of Education, MoET and DoET regulations for school licensure we have made changes to our Grade 11 Program. We are confident that such changes further the Canadian International School’s commitment to *Intellect and Heritage* to ensure our Vietnamese students’ understanding and appreciation of their cultural roots.

The following regulations govern curriculum expectations for all Vietnamese Nationals:

- Grades 1 through 3 students study Vietnamese Language, Civics and Social Science.
- Students in **Grades 4 to 12** study Vietnamese Language and Literature, Civics, History and Geography.

Beginning in 2018 - 2019 CIS Vietnamese students in Grades 10 through 12 will receive an additional report card with the distinct marks in each of these four Vietnamese subjects.

To meet MoET and DoET mandates, **all students in Grade 11 IBDP are required to attend the CIS Saturday Vietnamese Program.** Saturday morning classes begin at 8:30 AM and conclude at 12:15. This is the calendar of Saturdays:
